Plastic specula have one major drawback compared to metal versions: the material is more fragile. Simply put: until recently, most plastic specula could often not withstand the forces that they are exposed to in

practical use, which brings with it a risk of breaking or jamming.

That is why Bridea Medical designed the Orchid Spec. A real game-changer, tested by the authoritative Surgical Materials Testing Laboratory of the NHS in the UK. We even designed an extra test to look beyond the strength of an open speculum in a static locked position. By testing the product's strength during dynamic loading, we could more accurately gauge its performance in real-life situations. Much to the STML's delight, the Orchid Spec was the first speculum ever to pass all tests with flying colors.



For special procedures, Orchid Spec offers several additional options in various sizes.




Open-Sided
